

4. Earnest money as described in column no. 4 of tender form in the shape of Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) issued by a Nationalised bank duly pledged in favour of the Director, Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Mountaineering & Allied Sports, Manali, District Kullu, Himachal Pradesh payable at Manali-175131 (HP) should be furnished with tender. Tenders, which are not accompanied by earnest money and the requisite tender form, will be summarily rejected at the time of opening of tenders. The state Govt. Undertaking and the Govt. of India Undertakings shall be exempted from the deposit of earnest money alongwith the tenders. The refund of the amount of security and earnest money deposited by the firm will be made after the date of satisfactory execution of the given supply orders.
5. The tender must be accompanied by General Sales Tax, Central Sales Tax clearance certificates showing the clearance of taxes up to 31st March of the preceding year. However, the Government of India / Himachal Pradesh Government Undertakings and such tenderers holding current valid registration with the DGS&D and also small scale industrial units registered with the National Small Industries Corporation will be exempted from furnishing such clearance certificates. Local Industrial units who attached with the tender an attested copy of the permanent registration certificate issued by the General Manager, District Industries Centre concerned, will also be exempted from furnishing such clearance certificates but will have to submit no dues certificate from the concerned General Manager, DIC.
6. Samples must be compulsorily sent for items mentioned in Tender Notice from S.No. 1 to 80 quoted for on or before tender opening date. Such samples must be submitted and delivered in person or through their authorized representative or through parcel to the office at Manali Himachal Pradesh. Samples should bear a sealed label, marked with the tenderers name and address and reference to the item number. Loss of samples or damage or wear and tear by testing, exposure, experiment etc. shall be no ground for compensation in any form. It shall be responsibility of the tenderers to collect the samples after
