

the date of opening of the bid as specified, the bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

6. The bid for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids. If any bidder/tenderer withdraws his bid/tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid, the said earnest money shall stand forfeited.
7. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a Contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of the Government. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's Service.
8. The materials to be used shall be of ISI mark/standard make quality. The quality of materials shall have to be verified/passed by the board of officers concerned before start of work. The approved brand of cement/tar steel are as under:-
 - i) Cement of Ambuja, ACC, Birla Plus, JP.
 - ii) Tar Steel of SAIL, TATA TISCON, and Rashtriya ispat.
9. **Qualification criteria required for bidders is as under:-**
 - i) The contractor should have financial turnover of 40% of advertised cost in any one financial year in the last three financial years with the certificate issued by Chartered Accountant and duly supported by TDS and Income Tax Return.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO BIDDER.

1. **Scope of Bid.**
 - 1.1 The Official website and advertisement in newspaper invites bids for the construction of works (as described in these documents and referred to as "the works"). The name and identification number of the works is provided in the tender.
 - 1.2 Throughout these documents the terms "bid" and "tender" and their derivatives (bidder/tenderer, bid/tender, Bidding/tendering etc.) are synonymous.
